COMMUNION PRACTICE: The Biblical foundation for our practice may be found in Matt. 26:26-28, Mark 14:22-24, Luke 22:19-20, 1 Cor. 11:23-30. Christ has given Holy Communion as a spiritual blessing to His Church. In order to be responsible in sharing God's gift of Christ and His forgiveness in the Sacrament, our practice is to commune individuals who are baptized and instructed in the Christian faith, normally in the fellowship of a sister Lutheran congregation, and share unity in what we believe, teach, and practice about the Lord's Supper. If you have answered "no" or don't know the answer to this question, we respectfully ask that you await discussion with the Pastor before receiving Holy Communion for the first time. Thank you for your consideration. If you are not communing, but would like a blessing, please come forward and just fold your hands.
